




MUSEUM OF RURAL MEMORY

A cultural structure of the municipality of Carrazeda de Ansiães, located in Vilarinho da Castanheira, devoted to the preservation and dissemination of our material and intangible heritage. It is the first museum that covers different aspects of the Douro and Trás-os-Montes regions' rural culture.

It has a central rural museum building and smaller venues scattered around the territory.

Six exhibit centers open to visitors.



Learn all about traditional craftsmen, such as basket weavers, fishermen, bakers, cheese-makers, weavers, shepherds, coopers, cobblers, tinkers, millers and cork harvesters.

MUSEUM CENTER

This museum is located in the village of Lavandeira. Here you can see how olive oil was traditionally produced using an olive oil press with a central fixing screw. The exhibit depicts the entire traditional olive oil production process, which begins with the olive harvest.



This museum is located in the village of Seixo de Ansiães and provides a representation of two of the county's most traditional trades.

MUSEUM CENTER

This museum is located in an old roof tile factory in Luzelos, parts of which have survived to the present day. Here visitors learn about the craft roof tile production process, from the extraction and baking of the clay to its sale and distribution in the Douro region.

WINDMIL

The rarity of windmills in Trás-os-Montes makes this one a curiosity and great attraction. It was built in the early 20th century. It was used for around 10 years to grind wheat from the fields around the town of Carrazeda de Ansiães. It was fully restored in 2012.



RIBEIRO DO COITO WATERMILLS

Located nearby the village of Vilarinho da Castanheira, the area was also known as the "mills village". They have been restored and now make up part of a bucolic park. Visitors can enjoy communing with nature and appreciate the ingenuity used to build these watermills.

It details the crushing, frail-pressing, scalding, pressing and final decantation to obtain a fine thread of olive oil.



Inside there are a forge and bellows dating back to the days of the blacksmith, along with all the tools used and some of the items crafted there. The courtyard reflects the farrier's work shoeing horses, with information about the tools and techniques used.
